



<p>Sacraments to the Home Bound Please inform the pastor if you know of anyone who is homebound so that we can insure that they are afforded ample opportunities to receive the Sacraments. We would rather be notified by several people than to not be notified at all, so please don't presume that someone else has already notified us.</p>	<p>Sacrament of Baptism The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is administered upon request. Parents and Godparents must attend an evening class on Baptism in the Catholic Church. Please contact the pastor and set up an appointment for this class at least a month in advance. At least one parent must be a practicing Catholic for their child to be baptized in the Catholic Church. Godparents must be at least 16 years of age and at least one must be a practicing Catholic.</p>
<p>Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick The Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick is celebrated upon request, and at least four times a year at all the weekend Masses. Please notify the pastor or call the parish office if you know of anyone who might need this sacrament, but may not be able to notify the pastor personally. Please inform the pastor if you or any one in your family is in the hospital. If you notify us before surgery, we can celebrate this sacrament before you are admitted to the hospital. If your doctor is willing, we can also have a blessing for him/her at the time of your anointing.</p>	<p>Sacrament of Marriage A couple wishing to marry must contact the priest at least six months prior to the desired wedding date. According to the guidelines of our diocese, you should not make absolute plans for a specific wedding date until after meeting with the priest. The couple will be required to attend a marriage preparation course which will include at least one formal program such as an Engaged Encounter Weekend or the Sponsor Couple Program.</p>

As human beings, we ask many questions in our daily life related to various situations we face and hear about. Some of the questions are very personal and some are not. Some questions are useful for our lives and some are not. We are eager to ask questions to the other but very rarely do we ask questions to ourselves. Through today's gospel Jesus invites us to look into one's own self and ask questions.

The most powerful and beautiful meditation one can make during his/her earthly life is to reflect deeply about ones own self and find out, who am I? Yes, a serious call for self realization. I would say absence of this self realization is the major cause of most of our problems. In fact, no one wants to have problems, but at the same time, no one has the time for self realization.

Today, Jesus is asking us to forget about all the other questions of our life and ask only two questions about our life. Who do people say I am? and Who do you say that I am? Yes, to be successful and uplift our life, we need to seriously consider these two questions.

Each one of us live here in this world with a purpose, otherwise no one can be happy. So in the same way, Jesus came into this world with a special purpose. As His ministry is progressing, He is checking with his disciples as to whether His mission is going in the right direction or not. It is in this process Jesus asks His disciples these two questions. It shows how sincere and committed Jesus is.

Yes, to be sincere and committed to our life situations, we need to analyze these questions in our family and community. A father in the family should check with his wife and children whether he is living according to their expectation as husband and father. A mother in the family should check with her husband and children as to whether she is living according to their expectation as wife and mother.

As children of God, Jesus comes to us with these questions. Surely just like the disciples, we will have so many answers for the first question. But what is the answer you are going to give for the second and most important question - Who do you say that I am? Be sure, a right answer to this question can CHANGE our life to a beautiful realm. The answer to this question should be found not through a Google search or any other means, but rather it needs a serious reflection and personal encounter with Jesus.

Every sacrament we celebrate in the Holy Catholic Church is an occasion to have a serious meditation and personal encounter with God. Have you ever experienced Him to proclaim the greatest truth of our life and faith- **You are the Christ, Son of the Living God.**

Dear friends, everyone is created in a unique way, every one is loved and cared for in a unique way, every one is blessed and gifted in a unique way, and everyone's prayers are answered in a unique way. So each one of us are very unique and very special to Jesus. So we also have an obligation to give an answer in a unique way based on our experience. However, are you ready to say to Jesus from your heart- **Yes, You are the Christ, Son of the Living God.**

My dear friends, let us be different by standing out in our personal encounter with Jesus and proclaim to the whole world that- **My Christ Is the True and Ever Living God.**
