**Gospel Reflection**  
**For the weekend of November 17/18, 2012**

**“And they will see the Son of Man coming  
in the clouds...” Mark 13:24-32**

Are we ready to encounter “the Son of Man coming in the clouds?” We can be sure He won’t be coming just to wave and say hello or talk about the weather. He will be coming to ask for an accounting of how we have done with all the talents, abilities and gifts God has given to us. Henry Youngman, the great Jewish humorist, quipped that “My uncle knew exactly when he was going to die. The warden told him.” Most of us will not have such a precise time for our passing. Now is the acceptable time to review and reflect on how we have cared for, used and shared all that God has entrusted to us. Will we be prepared to report to Jesus that we understood that all that we are and all that we have came from God and belongs to Him and that we used it to the best of our ability for ourselves and for others? What are we going to report when we see “the Son of Man coming in the clouds . . .?”

**QUO VADIS RETREAT**

The Vocations office for the Diocese of Owensboro will host a QUO VADIS vocations retreat on December 29, 2012 at St. Margaret’s Chapel in Henderson. The retreat will be a full day of discussions and information from the vocations office with specific talks given by seminarians. ### Sacrament of Baptism

The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is administered upon request. Parents and Godparents must attend an evening class on Baptism in the Catholic Church. Please contact the pastor and set up an appointment for this class at least a month in advance. At least one parent must be a practicing Catholic for their child to be baptized in the Catholic Church. Godparents must be at least 16 years of age, and at least one must be a practicing Catholic.

### Sacrament of Marriage

A couple wishing to marry must contact the priest at least six months before the desired wedding date. According to the guidelines of our diocese, you should not make absolute plans for a specific wedding date until after meeting with the pastor. The couple will be required to attend a marriage preparation course which will include at least one formal program such as an Engaged Encounter weekend or the Sponsor Couple Program.
