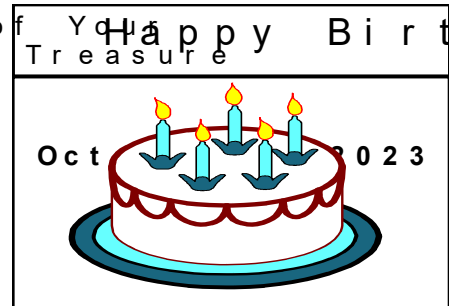

Sacrament of Marriage
 A couple wishing to marry must contact the priest at least 30 days before the desired wedding date. According to the Code of Canon Law, the couple must make absolute plans for a specific wedding. The couple will be required to attend a pre-wedding class. The class will include at least one formal program such as the Sponsor Couple Program.

Sacrament of Baptism
 The sacrament of baptism is the first step in the Christian life. It is a sign of God's grace and the beginning of a new life in Christ. The sacrament is celebrated by the priest or deacon, and the parents or godparents must be practicing Catholics. At least one must be a practicing Catholic.
