St. Peter Special Collection

One project that was approved was the replacement of the windows in the parish rectory. Parish council members noticed that the windows needed to be replaced when I moved in last June. We received two bids for replacing the windows. Both councils approved using Advanced Aluminum to replace the windows in the rectory. The cost for replacing these windows will be \$11,059. There are 22 windows in the rectory. I am grateful for your continued generosity; however, I also recognize that the cost is substantial for the parish. The weekends of March 26th and April 2nd we will be taking up a second collection at Masses for replacing the windows in the rectory for those who would like to help pay for the replacement windows. 



Sacrament of Baptism

The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is administered upon request. Parents and Godparents must attend an evening class on Baptism in the Catholic Church. Please contact the pastor and set up an appointment for this class at least a month in advance. At least one parent must be a practicing Catholic for their child to be baptized in the Catholic Church. Godparents must be at least 16 years of age, and at least one must be a practicing Catholic.
