St. Peter Special Collection

The Parish Council and Finance Council both approved our moving forward with our long term planning for the parish. One project that was approved was the replacement of the windows in the parish rectory. Parish council members noticed that the windows needed to be replaced when I moved in last June. We received two bids for replacing the windows. Both councils approved using Advance Aluminum to replace the windows in the rectory. The cost for replacing these windows will be \$11,059. There are 22 windows in the rectory. I am grateful for your continued generosity; however, I also recognize that the cost is substantial for the parish. The weekends of March 26th and April 2nd we will be taking up a second collection at Masses for replacing the windows in the rectory for those who would like to help pay for the replacement windows. Thank you for your witness of faith, and your continued generosity.

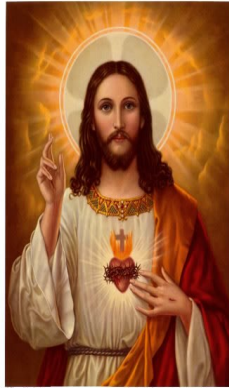

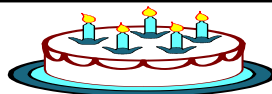
