Fifth Sunday of Lent

John 8:1-11

“Let the one among you who is without sin be the first to throw a stone at her.”

Old habits can be very enslaving and often cause resistance to venture into new and better ways. The Scripture today reminds us, that breaking away from the past is very essential to obtaining eternal life with Christ Jesus. In the Gospel today we see, as the pharisees and the scribes accuse the woman of committing adultery, Jesus invites them to examine their conscience - so to begin a new life centered on forgiveness. They however ignore the invitation and walk away. The question is how about you and I, do I take to heart the invitation of Jesus to forgive? Alone with Jesus, the woman not only experiences freedom from her past, her accusers and their punishment, But she experiences true freedom that comes from the forgiveness Jesus gives to her. The woman is given another chance. The Lord's mercy is infinite, and when we continually seek forgiveness for our sins, He grants it. May the grace of this Lenten season draw us more and more to the mercy of God and be renewed, work on any of our transgressions, let go, so to truly enter into a Christ-centered life. And as we experience forgiveness and healing, in turn learn to forgive and bring healing to others.

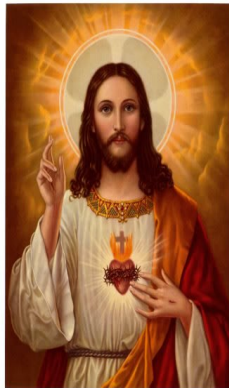
