**Returning to the Celebration of Public Mass**

We all long for the day when we can gather with our entire parish community for the celebration of the Eucharist. We value the communal nature of the Mass and we know that when any part of our community is missing, the celebration is lacking. However, we are also aware of our obligation to respect the dignity of every human life. Because of this, and out of a sense of Christian charity, we must celebrate the Mass with restrictions for the time being. **Parish Gatherings Outside the Liturgy**

Effective immediately, parish gatherings outside the liturgy (Religious Education classes, RCIA meetings, small groups, etc.) may resume with ten people or less, with the following guidelines:

- All must continue practicing physical distancing of six feet from those not living within the same household.
- All must wear a mask if closer than six feet to anyone not living within their household.
- No communal food may be shared.
- Encourage all to wash hands frequently before, during, and after the gathering.
- Encourage all to avoid touching their eyes, nose, and mouth.
- Those at high risk over 65 with heart, lung, or kidney disease, are still asked not to gather.

## Pentecost Sunday

John 20:19-23

"As the Father has sent me,  
so I send you."

A "disciple" is one who "follows." An "apostle" is one who is "sent." Before Jesus was crucified and rose from the dead his disciples followed him. When he appeared to his disciples in the upper room where they were hiding behind locked doors for fear of the Jews, he breathed the Spirit on them and "sent" them into the world to complete his mission and proclaim his message to all people. Fifty days after the Passover, on the Jewish Feast of Pentecost, the Spirit filled them with wisdom and courage. They left the upper room to proclaim Jesus to all the world by what they said and did. They stood among people both familiar and foreign, some friendly and others fierce foes. They understood the challenge and the consequences. They took the risk of imitating Jesus and did not waiver in the face of opposition and dangers. We have been sent by Jesus. Can we do less? Can we do more?



### **Sacrament of Marriage**

A couple wishing to marry must contact the priest at least six months before the desired wedding date. According to the guidelines of our diocese, you should not make absolute plans for a specific wedding date until after meeting with the pastor. The couple will be required to attend a marriage preparation course which will include at least one formal program such as an Engaged Encounter weekend or the Sponsor Couple Program.

### **Sacraments to the Home-Bound**

Please inform the pastor or the parish office if you know of anyone who is home-bound, so that we can insure that they are afforded ample opportunities to receive the Sacraments. We would rather be notified by several people than to not be notified at all, so please don't presume that someone else has already notified us.

### **Sacrament of Baptism**

The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is administered upon request. Parents and Godparents must attend an evening class on Baptism in the Catholic Church. Please contact the pastor and set up an appointment for this class at least a month in advance. At least one parent must be a practicing Catholic for their child to be baptized in the Catholic Church. Godparents must be at least 16 years of age, and at least one must be a practicing Catholic.
