John 20:19-23
"Peace be with you."

On Pentecost Sunday we celebrate the outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon the Church, the birthday of the Church. The Gospel today recounts Jesus' after resurrection sudden appearance to His disciples and shared with them the first gifts of resurrection; forgiveness and peace. He sends them out to share the same gifts to others. The peace of the Risen Lord and all the gifts of His Spirit unlocks the doors of the upper room, as well as the hearts and lives of the apostles, on Pentecost, as narrated in Acts. The disciples, filled with the Holy Spirit, boldly communicate to others the peace and joy they have received in a language that could be understood by all people from different places and languages. They spoke a universal language of Pentecost; love, peace, forgiveness, and hope, inviting all to a life of discipleship - a life of love and self giving, a call to enter into a personal relationship with Christ, to share their very life with Christ with others. As missionary disciples of Jesus today, therefore, we are called to speak and witness by our very lives the language of Pentecost; love, self giving, forgiveness, hope, and peace.

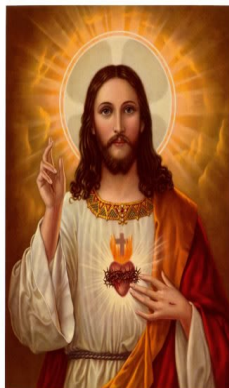
