#### Dear Friends in Jesus Christ,

As we begin to reflect about today's Gospel, the first question we need to ask ourselves is-am I really called by Jesus? If I am really called by Jesus personally, did I ever try to find out the purpose of my calling and lived accordingly? The Gospel states that the very purpose of Jesus' calling His disciples is to be with Him and to be sent out. I am sure, being the disciples of Jesus in this 21<sup>st</sup> century, the purpose of our call is not different either. If so let us examine the purpose of our call.

TO BE WITH THE LORD: How faithful am I, in being with the Lord -through my holy life of Loving God and neighbor in all possible ways? Do I find time for my Lord, as He is finding time for my needs? Only if we have true love for someone, we will find time to be with that particular person. Only by being with someone we can know the person well and love him or her. If so, how much we know our God and how much we love Him? If we say we love Him, how can we rebel against Him through our sinful ways of life? Only by fulfilling the first purpose we can step into the process of second purpose of our calling to be sent out.

TO BE SENT OUT: It is about the second purpose of our Christian call, the Gospel of today is talking to us. Yes, the disciples are sent out to preach the Good News of Repentance. If you remember the Gospel of last weekend, we know that going out to preach the Good News of Repentance is not an easy job, because Jesus Himself had bitter experience from His own home town people. Preaching about repentance means, telling the people on their face that; what you are doing not right, you need to change your ways of life and turn towards God. We know Jesus, St. John the Baptist, the disciples and many other saints went around and preached about the repentance and they had to cost their lives in this world. Yes, only a true prophet can preach about the repentance boldly, and only a true disciple of Jesus can accept that repentance in his or her life and become a prophet in this world. In today's world we don't find anyone like Jesus or John the Baptist or disciples or any other martyrs in the church, because everyone is trying to do a compromise preaching without hurting anyone, and no one is dare to preach the Gospel of repentance in its true spirit. Dear friends, true freedom is not your will to do whatever you want, but it is your will to do the right things always.

Dear friends, every one of us are called to be a prophet. To be an effective prophet, Jesus sets out certain instructions through the Gospel for our lives as we are already being sent out. All the directions given by Jesus are leading us to one point of placing our trust in the Lord completely than worldly things and move forward without any fear. This is the experience St. Paul preaches to us in the

Romans 8:31 "If God is for us, who can be against us." Yes, we are all sent out to this world with the power and authority that comes from the Lord. So, to execute Lords' power and authority effectively through our lives in this world, let us be connected to God always and thus be faithful to the call we have received from Him by fulfilling the purpose of our call. it is about this power and authority we pray every day through the prayer of St. Francis.

#### Sacrament of Marriage

A couple wishing to marry must contact the priest at least six months before the desired wedding date. According to the guidelines of our diocese, you should not make absolute plans for a specific wedding date until after meeting with the pastor. The couple will be required to attend a marriage preparation course which will include at least one formal program such as an Engaged Encounter weekend or the Sponsor Couple Program.

#### Sacrament of Baptism

The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is administered upon request. Parents and Godparents must attend an evening class on Baptism in the Catholic Church. Please contact the pastor and set up an appointment for this class at least a month in advance. At least one parent must be a practicing Catholic for their child to be baptized in the Catholic Church. Godparents must be at least 16 years of age, and at least one must be a practicing Catholic.

#### Sacraments to the Home-Bound

Please inform the pastor or the parish office if you know of anyone who is home-bound, so that we can insure that they are afforded ample opportunities to receive the Sacraments. We would rather be notified by several people than to not be notified at all, so please don't presume that someone else has already notified us.
