### **Mount St. Joseph Bricks Available**

Those who would like to preserve a part of Mount Saint Joseph Academy/Conference and Retreat Center may donate to the Ursuline Sisters of Mount Saint Joseph to secure one of the "miracle bricks" that Father Paul Joseph Volk created in 1874 to build the Academy. The bricks — now 149 years old — began to disintegrate in recent years, making the original building and its additions unsafe. Before the deconstruction of the 1874 building, 500 bricks were saved for posterity. (The Academy operated until 1983 before the building became the Mount Saint Joseph Conference and Retreat Center, which was open until 2020.) For a suggested donation of \$25, a brick will be reserved in your name. The bricks can be picked up at Mount Saint Joseph in Maple Hall (the former gym) off Cummings Road on Saturday, July 22 from 9 a.m.-11 a.m. CT. Academy alumnae may also pick up their brick on August 27 during the Academy reunion weekend. The bricks will not be shipped. Each person may order a maximum of three bricks. The bricks will come with a certificate of authenticity. You can secure a brick by writing a check to the Ursuline Sisters and mailing it to: Academy Brick, 8001 Cummings Road, Maple Mount, KY 42356. 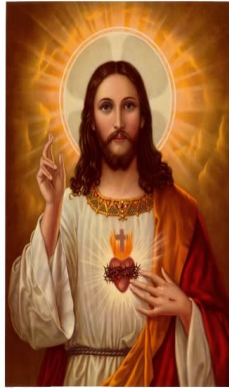

### **Sacrament of Marriage**

A couple wishing to marry must contact the priest at least six months before the desired wedding date. According to the guidelines of our diocese, you should not make absolute plans for a specific wedding date until after meeting with the pastor. The couple will be required to attend a marriage preparation course which will include at least one formal program such as an Engaged Encounter weekend or the Sponsor Couple Program.

### **Sacrament of Baptism**

The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is administered upon request. Parents and Godparents must attend an evening class on Baptism in the Catholic Church. Please contact the pastor and set up an appointment for this class at least a month in advance. At least one parent must be a practicing Catholic for their child to be baptized in the Catholic Church. Godparents must be at least 16 years of age, and at least one must be a practicing Catholic.

### **Sacraments to the Home-Bound**

Please inform the pastor or the parish office if you know of anyone who is home-bound, so that we can insure that they are afforded ample opportunities to receive the Sacraments. We would rather be notified by several people than to not be notified at all, so please don't presume that someone else has already notified us.
