

#### Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time Mark 6:30-34 "The Lord is my shepherd, there is nothing I shall want."

The goal of every good shepherd is to gather and lead their flocks with the necessary care, so that they might be fruitful and multiply. Prophet Jeremiah underscores the kind of shepherd the Lord desires; shepherds that gather His flock as opposed to those that scatter. The Lord promised to appoint new shepherds to gather His flock, tend to their needs, and so to be fruitful and multiply. In the Gospel, Jesus, seeing the crowd, compares them to a shepherdless flock. So He reaches out to them with great compassion. Jesus is the true and caring shepherd, appointed to gather us, His flock, to God's embrace. St. Paul to the Ephesians reiterates: Christ Jesus who is our peace, put hostility to death through the cross, both as a sacrificial lamb and a true shepherd to reconcile us to God. Today, gathered around the sacrificial table, we encounter our ever caring and compassionate shepherd. who, out of care speaks to us in His word, feeds us with His own body and blood - a nourishment to our souls, and sends us to be the bread that is broken for one another. Our First Communicant children will experience for the first time Christ, the true, caring, compassionate shepherd, as He feeds them with His body and blood in the Eucharist. May we always, be conscious of His presence and company. May we trust Christ, the true shepherd, and confidently declare as the psalmist, "The Lord is my shepherd, there is nothing I shall want."



#### **Sacrament of Baptism**

The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is administered upon request. Parents and Godparents must attend an evening class on Baptism in the Catholic Church. Please contact the pastor and set up an appointment for this class at least a month in advance. At least one parent must be a practicing Catholic for their child to be baptized in the Catholic Church. Godparents must be at least 16 years of age, and at least one must be a practicing Catholic.

#### Sacraments to the Home-Bound

Please inform the pastor or the parish office if you know of anyone who is home-bound, so that we can insure that they are afforded ample opportunities to receive the Sacraments. We would rather be notified by several people than to not be notified at all, so please don't presume that someone else has already notified us.
