Dear Friends in Jesus Christ,

After having listened to the instructions, and using the power and authority given by Jesus this past Sunday, in today's Gospel, we see the disciples are coming back to Jesus to report to Him about the result of their missionary work. From the Gospel, we understand that they had a very fruitful and successful mission work that people were flocking to them that *"they had no opportunity to eat."* But, Jesus says to them, very clearly, to take a break from their ministry by saying *"come away by yourself to a deserted place."* Dear friends, it is an invitation to be with Him again, so that they could be sent out again for further missionary work. Here Jesus affirms that it is not enough that we do much work for the glory of God, but He expects our presence with Him through our prayers, reading of the word of God, participation of sacraments etc., too.

Dear friends, our coming to Church every day or every weekend and going after the Church is same as today's Gospel. We are coming to the Church to be with the Lord and to experience Him through the celebration of the Holy Eucharist. And when the Eucharistic celebration is concluded by the final greetings from the priest *"the mass is ended, let us go in the peace and love of Christ"* we are all sent out for a mission to give Jesus to everyone we meet in our lives. Today, when we are all gathered here in this Church, like the disciples coming back to Jesus to report about their mission; what do we have today to report to Jesus about the mission that we did during the past week? What do you think, have you done well in your ministry? We were all sent out with power and authority-how well did we use them to bring at least little change in the life of another person? Let us make a serious examination of ourselves.

The Gospel of today says that Jesus' *"heart was moved with pity for them, for they were like a sheep without a shepherd."* Jesus says, *"a true shepherd lays down his life for his sheep."* Every Christian is called to be a true shepherd by loving God and our neighbor. How many of us can say from our hearts that we have been a good shepherd through our lives? If we think, we have been a good shepherd, how come many sheep from our family

and church family have fallen away from the Catholic faith?

Dear friends, the world needs many people like Jesus with love, care, affection, compassion etc., to get back the lost sheep from our family and our church family. Remember, even though we get lost in the worldly attractions, often times, Christ has not lost His hope in all of us. Because He is a good shepherd and He proved it by laying His life for all of us. Today, Jesus is calling us for the same, to be a good shepherd: *"come away by yourself to a deserted place, to be with Him and to be sent out."*

Sacrament of Marriage

A couple wishing to marry must contact the priest at least six months before the desired wedding date. According to the guidelines of our diocese, you should not make absolute plans for a specific wedding date until after meeting with the pastor. The couple will be required to attend a marriage preparation course which will include at least one formal program such as an Engaged Encounter weekend or the Sponsor Couple Program.

Sacrament of Baptism

The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is administered upon request. Parents and Godparents must attend an evening class on Baptism in the Catholic Church. Please contact the pastor and set up an appointment for this class at least a month in advance. At least one parent must be a practicing Catholic for their child to be baptized in the Catholic Church. Godparents must be at least 16 years of age, and at least one must be a practicing Catholic.

Sacraments to the Home-Bound

Please inform the pastor or the parish office if you know of anyone who is home-bound, so that we can insure that they are afforded ample opportunities to receive the Sacraments. We would rather be notified by several people than to not be notified at all, so please don't presume that someone else has already notified us.
