## 17th Sunday in Ordinary Time Luke 11:1-13

G.K. Chesterton once wrote; "The fact is that purification and austerity are even more necessary for the appreciation of life and laughter than for anything else. To let no bird fly past unnoticed, to spell patiently the stones and weeds, to have the mind a storehouse of sunsets, requires a discipline in pleasure and an education in gratitude." (*Twelve Types*) Chesterton recognized that a grateful heart is one based upon discipline. That requires taking the opportunity to be aware of what happens around us and who is in our life. This last weekend, St. Peter of Alcantara hosted a drive through picnic. It was a first picnic of the sorts for me. I spent Friday and Saturday listening, observing, and talking with many who have helped over the years. I spoke with those who helped run the picnic in the years past, witnessed those who spent significant time, labor, and sweat to make the picnic a success once again. I noticed a longing for times past and witnessed a community of people coming together to ensure the picnic happened. Like all major events things went sideways a time or two; however, I noticed how quickly people adapted and overcame various obstacles. What I took away from the picnic was a group of people who love their parish and love one another. The great things of the picnic were not the dip dogs, nor the gizzards and livers (though those were enjoyed) the great things of the picnic came from people spending time together. Cutting vegetables, deboning meat, trimming meat, opening cans, manning the fire, stirring the burgoo, packaging the food, selling the desserts, and the lucky winners being drawn to win the money. The great things were not things, but the people who were present. Wednesday evening, I caught up with a childhood friend. He asked the following: "Was the picnic a success?" A group of people who love this parish and express it in different ways. A group who overcame heat, and things going sideways to make the picnic work. 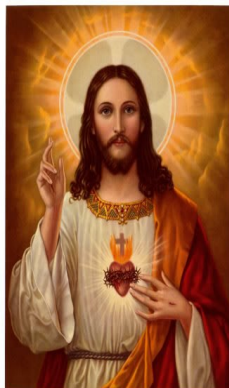

### Sacrament of Marriage

A couple wishing to marry must contact the priest at least six months before the desired wedding date. According to the guidelines of our diocese, you should not make absolute plans for a specific wedding date until after meeting with the pastor. The couple will be required to attend a marriage preparation course which will include at least one formal program such as an Engaged Encounter weekend or the Sponsor Couple Program.

### Sacrament of Baptism

The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is administered upon request. Parents and Godparents must attend an evening class on Baptism in the Catholic Church. Please contact the pastor and set up an appointment for this class at least a month in advance. At least one parent must be a practicing Catholic for their child to be baptized in the Catholic Church. Godparents must be at least 16 years of age, and at least one must be a practicing Catholic.

### Sacraments to the Home-Bound

Please inform the pastor or the parish office if you know of anyone who is home-bound, so that we can insure that they are afforded ample opportunities to receive the Sacraments. We would rather be notified by several people than to not be notified at all, so please don't presume that someone else has already notified us.
