Dear Friends in Jesus Christ,

Miracles are happening in each and every moment of our lives, but we fail to realize them because our hearts are closed to an extent due to our lack of holiness. As a consequence, we continue to make complaints to God and to others about the things which we do not have. In today's Gospel we see, people are bringing a person who is deaf and dumb, who cannot hear and speak, and Jesus heals this man in a different way; putting his finger into his ears and spitting and touching his tongue.

If we seriously and sincerely relate this healing done by Jesus, to our personal life, there is no doubt, most of us are in need of a same kind of healing. Trust me, in today's world, we have so many deaf, dumb and blind people in need of healing, including most of us. If we are looking for a positive change in this world, a great healing should take place in this human world. If you have observed the celebration of the sacrament of Baptism, during which the priest makes special prayers and consecration for eyes, mouth and ears, with the purpose to glorify God; but do we live up to that in using them? Yes, dear friends, if God has blessed someone with an ability to speak - that is bless others and glorify God, Eyes, to glorify the beauty of God's creation, and Ears, to hear the word of God; but how do we use them in our daily lives? In every celebration of the Holy Eucharist, just before the Gospel, we all make sign of the cross over the forehead and bless it-to understand the word of God, over the mouth-to speak what is understood and over the heart-to keep the word of God and living accordingly. But anything happening according to the religious signs we do during the celebration? This is the reason, last weekend Jesus said *"This people honors me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me; in vain do they worship me, teaching as doctrines human precepts."*

Yes, dear friends, as we reflect about this Gospel, there is no doubt we all need a healing touch of God. The Gospel says, Jesus groaned and said *"Ephphatha"*. Because Jesus realized there are people with eyes, but don't see, ears, but don't hear, a mouth, but don't speak. Jesus says *"Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in and dine with him, and he with me."* (Rev. 3:20) Yes, Jesus is ready to touch and heal us, and open our eyes, ears, hearts and mouth, but often we are not prepared.

Yes, we have closed our eyes, when we failed to help the needy. Yes, we have closed our mouth, when we failed to speak for justice, freedom and fellowship and failed to respond to the cry of the poor. Yes, we have closed our hearts, when we failed to forgive our own fellow brothers and sisters. So, let us pray, Lord, come to our lives, give us a healing touch. **May God Bless You.**

Sacrament of Marriage

A couple wishing to marry must contact the priest at least six months before the desired wedding date. According to the guidelines of our diocese, you should not make absolute plans for a specific wedding date until after meeting with the pastor. The couple will be required to attend a marriage preparation course which will include at least one formal program such as an Engaged Encounter weekend or the Sponsor Couple Program.

Sacrament of Baptism

The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is administered upon request. Parents and Godparents must attend an evening class on Baptism in the Catholic Church. Please contact the pastor and set up an appointment for this class at least a month in advance. At least one parent must be a practicing Catholic for their child to be baptized in the Catholic Church. Godparents must be at least 16 years of age, and at least one must be a practicing Catholic.

Sacraments to the Home-Bound

Please inform the pastor or the parish office if you know of anyone who is home-bound, so that we can insure that they are afforded ample opportunities to receive the Sacraments. We would rather be notified by several people than to not be notified at all, so please don't presume that someone else has already notified us.
